School-Wide Expectation:

Date Taught: April 10, 2009

Name of Skill: Creating positive bathroom behavior

Introduce the Expectation:

1. Return to class promptly
2. Maintain personal hygiene
3. Keep restroom clean
4. Flush
5. Wash your hands
6. Clean up after yourself
7. Report restroom destruction

Points of Discussion:

1. Helen never goes to the bathroom between classes. At the beginning of every class she asks to go to the bathroom. What could she be doing differently?
2. You are in the restroom and you notice another student about to leave without washing his/her hands. What would you say?
3. You are in the restroom and notice another student has thrown their paper towel onto the floor instead of putting it into the trash can. What would you say?
4. You are entering the stall or urinal and notice another student has not flushed. He/she is now at the sink washing his/her hands? What would you say?
5. As you walk into the restroom you notice that a student is scratching something into the stall wall. What would you do?
6. As you enter the bathroom you notice a student putting whole rolls of toilet paper into the toilet. What should you do?
